

TOWN OF WEST TISBURY - BY-LAWS ADOPTED AT TOWN MEETINGS

MOTOR VEHICLE

ATM 11 February 1924 - Book 1 p. 303

All vehicles using a traveled way shall keep to the right of all white lines painted or placed in such ways by authority of State Highway Commission and the Constables are authorized to enforce this by-law.

MOTOR VEHICLES, Rented Mopeds, etc.

STM 21 December 1981 - Book 4 p. 410

In the interest of public safety, no rented or leased moped, motorized bicycle or tri-ped shall be operated within the limits of the Town between the hours of 9:00 AM and 5:00 PM.

Disapproved by the Attorney General 5 April 1982 because it is inconsistent with state law.

MOTOR VEHICLES, Speed

STM 21 December 1981 - Book 4 p. 411

No person shall drive or operate a motor vehicle on a public way within the Town at a rate of speed inconsistent with public safety or convenience.

Whoever violates this by-law shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$20.00.

Approved by the Attorney General 5 April 1982

Motor Vehicle - Book 9 ATM April 10, 2007

ARTICLE 16: To see if the Town will vote to rescind the Town Bylaw "Motor Vehicle" voted at the Annual Town Meeting February 11, 1924. This bylaw requires all vehicles to travel to the right of all white lines painted on the town roads. (RECOMMENDED 4-0)
