BEACH POLICIES

The Town of West Tisbury has two beach sites- Lamberts Cove Beach and Uncle Seth's Pond. We welcome you to our beaches and ask that you observe the following regulations:

BEACH HOURS: Uncle Seth's Pond is open from 6 a.m. until 9 p.m. daily. Lamberts Cove Beach is open from 7 a.m. until 9 p.m. Beach and night fishing passes are available at the Parks & Recreation building at the West Tisbury School tennis courts.

PARKING: Limited parking is available at Lamberts Cove in the lot and in designated areas on the roadside, only where signs permit and with all tires completely off the pavement. Per order of the West Tisbury Police Dept., there will no longer be parking on the south side of Lambert's Cove Rd. opposite the parking area. Very limited parking is available at Uncle Seth's Pond. Please drive SLOWLY, park within designated areas only, and keep all tires off of the pavement. REMEMBER; CARS PARKED ILLEGALLY WILL BE TICKETED AND TOWED! Please use the shuttle bus if possible.

LIFEGUARDS: A lifeguard will be on duty at Lamberts Cove Beach from 10 a.m. until 5 p.m. daily from late June through Labor Day. There will be no lifeguard on duty at Uncle Seth's Pond; swim at your own risk.

STICKERS & PASSES: Access to Lamberts Cove Beach is reserved for West Tisbury residents only, from late June through Labor Day. There will be an attendant on duty at the parking lot, and visitors must present a valid pass or sticker adhered to their car to gain access to the beach. Uncle Seth's Pond is open to the public.

TRASH: *There are no trash receptacles at either site. ANYTHING CARRIED ON TO THE BEACH OR PARKING LOT MUST BE CARRIED OFF.*

NO ANIMALS allowed on the beach from 10 a.m. until 6:30 p.m. **Owners must collect all waste and dispose of it off-site.**

NO GLASS is permitted at any time. This includes bottles, drinking glasses, jugs, etc.

TRESPASSING: All visitors must stay within the Town beach area. Please respect the rights and privacy of our neighbors. Also please assist beach conservation efforts and keep everyone, including children, off the dunes.

CHILDREN: All children under the age of 12 must be supervised by an adult.

BOATS: No launching or landing of boats is permitted in the swim area. No motorized boats or personal watercraft are allowed within the swim area.

ACTIVITY: No activity that may disturb or endanger others is allowed. No nudity, fireworks or loud radios. No fires without a permit.

EVENTS: All events to occur at a Town beach must submit a completed Beach Event Permit, available at the Parks & Recreation office. The permit fee is \$100. A refundable deposit of \$100 is required for events of 15 or more people not to exceed 100. Please send two separate checks.

Any violation of the beach rules may result in revocation of beach privileges.
