

Lamberts Cove Beach Group Use Policy

Lamberts Cove Beach is owned by the Town of West Tisbury, and is managed by the Parks & Recreation Committee, for the use of West Tisbury residents and their guests. All regular and posted beach regulations must be adhered to. Special arrangements must be made for any private use, or for use by groups (defined as a gathering of more than 15 persons)

Group use of the beach during daytime hours (10 a.m. – 5 p.m.) is under the supervision of the Summer Program Director and/or lifeguards. For safety reasons, all groups shall provide their own Red Cross certified lifeguards at a ratio of one adult guard per 10 persons under the age of 18. Groups shall notify the Parks & Recreation Department (508-696-0147) of plans to use the beach. All groups of 20 or more are limited to 2 beach visits per season, and these visits must be pre-approved by the Parks & Recreation Department.

Parking

Car stickers are issued to residents and renters of property in West Tisbury, and are valid for parking only when affixed to the vehicle registered on the sticker application form. Commercial passes are issued at the commercial rate and are transferable between vehicles (one pass per vehicle) and allow parking in the lot and beach access for vehicle occupants. These passes are intended for family-sized vehicles only. Larger vehicles (passenger vans, etc) require special parking arrangements to be made in advance with the Parks & Recreation Department,

Walk-on beach access is for pass holders as outlined in the Parks & Recreation Department Beach Sticker Information. Each pass is valid for 2 adults and their children.
