NOTICE OF APPLICATION AND REQUEST FOR COMMENTS

D.P.U. 13-87/13-88/13-91/13-94/13-95/13-96

July 17, 2013

Applications by the towns of West Tisbury, Brewster, Provincetown, Barnstable, Chatham, and Orleans for approval by the Department of Public Utilities of a transfer of net metering capacity to the Cape and Vineyard Electric Cooperative, Inc., pursuant to G.L. c. 164, § 139(h).

Between the dates of July 1 and July 16, 2013, the towns of West Tisbury, Brewster, Provincetown, Barnstable, Chatham, and Orleans each filed an application with the Department of Public Utilities ("Department") seeking approval of a transfer of net metering capacity to the Cape and Vineyard Electric Cooperative ("CVEC"), pursuant to G.L. c. 164, § 139(h). The Department docketed these matters as D.P.U. 13-87/13-88/13-91/13-94/13-95.

West Tisbury seeks to transfer 750 kilowatts ("kW") to CVEC. Brewster seeks to transfer 3,750 kW to CVEC. Provincetown seeks to transfer 135 kW to CVEC. Barnstable seeks to transfer 5,750 kW to CVEC. Chatham seeks to transfer 750 kW to CVEC. Orleans seeks to transfer 500 kW to CVEC.

Any person interested in this matter may submit written comments to the Department no later than the close of business (5:00 p.m.) on **Wednesday, August 7, 2013**. One (1) original and one (1) copy of all comments should be delivered to Mark Marini, Secretary, Department of Public Utilities, One South Station, 5th Floor, Boston, Massachusetts 02110 by the dates and times referenced above. The text of the e-mail, disk label, or CD-ROM must specify: (1) the docket number (D.P.U. 13-87/13-88/13-91/13-94/13-95/13-96); (2) the name of the person or company submitting the filing; and (3) a brief descriptive title of the document. The electronic filing should also include the name, title, and telephone number of a person to contact in the event of questions about the filing.
