Reid explained that the existing lot has a septic and well on the property that was permitted for 550 gallons a day. He explained the water use would be from washing of linens, napkins and dishware from party rentals. Along with tent washing which may be washed outside in some fashion. The Board asked what the meter readings were from the Airport where they are located now, Jim said he didn't have the numbers with him. Erik asked what type of detergents or chemicals are used in the laundry and to clean the tents. Mr. Eddy wasn't sure. John will check with DEP to see if they would allow this type of use in a septic system.
