EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT: John reported on last nights all Island Selectman's meeting to discuss the High School Emergency Dispensing site. The out come of the meeting was that the Island Health Agents need to meet with the All Island Police chiefs to discuss the high school and the possibility of using other sites. Oak Bluffs Police Chief and the Dukes County Sheriff spoke against using the high school during the summer months. There was also an update from Tisbury DPW at the All Island Selectman's Meeting regarding the Land next to the Edgartown Transfer Station. The Board reviewed the list of classes they need to take for the 09 DPH deliverables.

OLD/NEW BUSINESS: The Board reviewed the revised plans for the proposed wind turbine for Boyle 7-117 that was sited on top of the existing septic system. The revised plans show the turbine just outside of the septic area. The Selectmen are schedule for the November 6<sup>th</sup> Meeting. The Board ordered a hearing to revoke the septic Haulers license for Maciel & Sons for failure to pay a fine imposed by the Board of Health. The Board reviewed the sanitary survey results for the West Tisbury School water system. The Board reviewed the mosquito control program report from T. J. Hagerty.
