MEETING MINUTES

Date of Meeting: 3/20/06

Meeting convened at 5 PM.

We unanimously approved the demolition of the Delli-Bovi barn, based on the opinion by barn expert Richard Anderson that the barn was beyond saving. We attached the following conditions to the application as approved:

Elevations, footprint, roof pitches are to remain as they are now.

The proposed East, West and North sides were approved as presented by the applicant.

The half round window on the South side was not approved.

A square or rectangular window may go on the south side instead of the half round (no larger than 2 ft x 2 ft)

No soffit under the roof overhang and wood boards will be the exposed material of the underside of the roof.

Azek, painted white, may be used as the trim, however the applicant must return for approval of the trim, with a list of the dimensions of the existing trim detail (thickness and width) which will be made and presented to the Commission because the barn is being demolished and the object is to replicate it as much as possible allowing for the fact that it will be a new structure.
