

WEST TISBURY HISTORIC DISTRICT COMMISSION MEETING
MEETING MINUTES

Date of Meeting: May 10, 2010

Meeting convened at 5:30 PM.

This was a hearing for proposed changes to 1045 State Road, the commercial building behind Alley's Store (formerly Back Alley's). The WTZBA denied the applicant's proposal for a take out window, so that is no longer part of the HDC application. There will be no take out window. We discussed the proposed signs and with Wenonah Madison on speakerphone, and filled in the details. The building sign will be the one shown on the bottom of submitted page one, with these changes and colors: The name of the business is "7a Foods". The font is as shown, the lettering color is hunter green, as is the border. The other wording "Martha's Vineyard" is chocolate brown, the mushroom symbol is a lighter green, and all the language at the bottom of the sign has been eliminated. The sign will be constructed of natural wood, pickled white to show the grain. The size of the building sign is 94" wide by 15" tall. The sign on the road, 38" wide by 27" tall, will be the same font and colors as the building sign, and will be the one shown on submitted page two left side. Two small signs will be attached to the main sign by chain link and will change to advertise seasonal offerings. A third attached sign will indicate the hours open.

There was a motion to approve the application. The motion was seconded and unanimously approved.
