

**WEST TISBURY PARKS AND RECREATION COMMITTEE
MINUTES MAY 7, 2008**

PRESENT: Rick Reinhardsen, Bob Holt, Doug Bardwell, Cheryl Lowe, and Peggy Stone. Also present for part of the meeting; Bob Lane

Minutes from previous meeting were approved as submitted.

Bob Lane came with the site plan for the flea market that will be at the West Tisbury School this summer. It will start Wed. 6/25. Rick asked how the spaces would be reserved for Park and Rec. Bob L. said they will have 2 kids and 2 parents in the parking lot directing people. They will have traffic cones reserving 15 spaces in front of the tennis courts. Doug asked who number one contact is if there are any questions. Bob gave his cell phone number to the committee. Bob H. asked about signs. The Flea market people are responsible for that. Bob H. commented that we don't want Park and Rec. people scared off. Bob L. assured it would be clear what is going on. The busses will be moved from out back as well. Labor Day weekend will be the last day of the market.

Rick will go ahead and order the new shed. We will put 2 tables and 2 chairs in the shed for people to fill out their applications. The old metal desk is still in the old shed; that can be used as well. Bob will speak with John George to get started on the slab. I will cost approx. \$2000 with slab and gravel. Peggy will speak to Bruce about the billing process.

There is lots of maintenance needed at LCB. The fence in front needs to be reset, the fence along the path has been torn away, the path needs raking and there is lots of trash around the shed. Rick suggested Brian Kennedy's crew to do some work or see what Jesse can do. Peggy will speak with Jen.

The Town Hall Renovation committee will be tearing out the whole basketball court not half as they had previously thought. The committee discussed relocating it to the School where the volleyball court is now. Rick suggested we put it on the next town warrant to see if the people want it. He will check on pricing to pour a court there.

Neila Decker from the library contacted Peggy about putting some playground equipment at the library while the town hall is under construction. She suggested if it works out there, they could possibly pay Park and Rec to keep it. Originally the committee thought it was a good idea but after the delays and change in costs, the committee doesn't feel they can afford to. Doug asked why the library doesn't just buy it themselves. Bob agreed, it doesn't make sense to do it twice. Rick reiterated the cost of installing twice doesn't work. Cheryl agreed. The committee unanimously decided not to buy playground equipment for the library.

The committee discussed names for the new tennis shed. They will continue thinking about it and email Peggy. The committee agreed to order a picnic table to put near the shed. Rick will order new keys for tennis. Peggy will order a sign for the shed and new rules sign for LCB.

The next meeting is set for Wed. June 4, 2008 at 7pm.
