**Vacation Carry-over:** *S. Manter motioned to authorized Joan Jenkinson to carry-over 15.7 hours of vacation time retroactive to her anniversary. D. Powers seconded the motion. The vote on the motion was unanimous in favor.*

**Conservation Appointment:** *S. Manter motioned to appoint Dan Pace to the Conservation Commission until the next appointment period. D. Powers seconded the motion. The vote on the motion was unanimous in favor.*

**School Parking Lot:** Jen said she had a request from someone asking for permission to use the school parking lot for an event she was having in August. The Board said it was fine.

**Email Policy:** *S. Manter motioned to adopt the email policy presented to them for review in June. D. Powers seconded the motion. The vote on the motion was unanimous in favor.*

**Tour busses on Music St.:** Dianne said the tour busses had begun to travel Music Street daily in both directions, which was both unsafe and bothersome to the residents because of the sheer numbers of them. She asked if we could present the company with an alternative route. Jen will draft a letter.

**NStar:** Jen said Richie Olsen reported that the bump on Old County road, caused by the electric work was worse. She said NStar had called her and said they were transferring the issue to legal council and would report back to the town in a week. Skipper said if in a week there was no action he would suggest the town fix the problem and send the bill to NStar.

**Parks & Rec shed electricity:** Ernie said it would cost about \$3,800 to run the power to the shed. If the department has the funds they can proceed.
