

Cyclical Inspections

June 3, 2026

The Massachusetts Department of Revenue requires assessors to inspect properties every ten years to ensure accurate property data. These inspections are called “cyclicals.” In early June, we will be mailing letters to property owners who are on our list to visit in the upcoming year.

Our data collection staff will have town-issued IDs and will be driving a town vehicle displaying the town seal.

Our staff will knock on the door when they arrive to request an interior inspection. These typically take 10 to 15 minutes. They will also conduct an exterior inspection. The Department of Revenue requires assessors to use estimates when inspections are not permitted by property owners.
