OLD/NEW BUSINESS: A septic plan and application was approved for a septic system for an existing 2 bedroom house with a 2 bedroom addition for Ivory Littlefield. The Board was informed that pre-opening beach testing was taking place for both Seth's Pond, Lambert's Cove and the other bathing beach applicants; results to be reported in a few days. The Board discussed Mr. Oliveira's request to construct an accessory structure under zoning by-laws for setback relief (4.2-2D) to

house his spray foam equipment used in his business. The discussion was aimed at addressing any immediate or far reaching concerns as they might relate to health, safety or environmental issues. Health Agent Johnson informed the Board that after a review of the MSDS sheets on the spray foam chemicals, that there were no health or environmental of concerns if the equipment was stored in the structure in the manner being proposed. It was discussed that most of the regulations regarding the storage or use of chemicals fall under the jurisdiction of the State Fire Marshall and the local fire chief, and the Board agreed that the local fire chief should be assisted by the Health Agent in determining whether specific requirements should be put in place to insure safety of both the environment and the public's health. The Board suggested the following: (1) That random inspections be conducted by the Fire Chief & Health Agent to determine that no chemicals are being stored at the property, (2) The Board will request receipts that the airport storage unit is being used for its intended purpose, and (3) The Board to receive some idea of where Mr. Oliveira plans to clean his foam insulating machine of residues that accumulate over time.
