

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OLD/NEW BUSINESS: Discussed the growing concern over residents directing their HVAC condensate to their septic systems. Health Agent Johnson sought advice on how this concern should be properly handled considering that no current regulations refer to this particular concern. Board member Lowe shared that the use of a condensate neutralizer might be a possibility. Also discussed was the possibility of drafting a memo that could be given to individuals at the time of constructions. Other suggestions made were to reach out to other aHealth agents on the island to speak with Billy the plumbing inspector. Health agent Johnson will need to follow up on the suggestions, then determine what is both lawful and feasible.
