LANDFILL/REFUSE DISTRICT: The Board was given an update as well as specific plans to make the LDO safer. The monthly figures from the MV Refuse & resource were also shared with the board.

BEACHES/EM/MDPH: The season for all beaches have officially ended. The Board was presented with the weekly Zika and local mosquito report and informed that the All-Island flu-clinic is being held at the high school on October 1<sup>st</sup>.

ANIMAL REVIEW FORM: Ray Muldaur 36-43 Currently in review by the Conservancy.

OLD/NEW BUSINESS: Discussed information shared from the synthetic turf inquiry and informed the Board that the Outbreak Net Enhanced summer pilot program had ended.
