**SELECTMENS MEETING**  
Wednesday, July 19, 2017 4:30 p.m. – 4:55 pm

**Present:** Selectmen Skipper Manter, Kent Healy, Jennifer Rand

**Also Present:** Paul Adler, Heather Hamacek

**No Parking Spot Across from Alley's Store:** Paul Adler said he lived Up-Island and found it very difficult to park in the Alley's parking lot to run simple errands like sending mail. He asked the Board if they would consider allowing parking in the spot across the street previously used by the busses. He noted that there was room for 1-2 cars closer to the Waldron driveway, which would leave site lines for those exiting the Library lot. Skipper said that he agreed that the area was very busy and getting in and out of the Alley's parking lot was difficult but the Board had given great thought to that parking spot and ultimately determined it just was not safe for people to park there. He suggested to Paul that there was parking in front of the Field Gallery that he could use and then walk over the Alley's using the available cross walk.

**Event Permits:** *K. Healy motioned to approve the following events at the Grange: Datz Art Show 8/5/17; Amalie Michel Linen sale 7/17-7/19 (retroactive) & Tuesdays @ Twilight for three dates. S. Manter seconded the motion. The vote on the motion was unanimous in favor.*

**Water Damage @ WT Library:** Jen said that Town Counsel had drafted a letter to the architect and builder of the Library to indicate there was a problem with the "bump-out" section and noting they were responsible to address it. She asked the Board if they were okay with the letter to send. Skipper said it was fine but suggested one minor edit. They Board then discussed asking a member of the Library Trustees to sit in on Facility meetings when the subject was discussed and further discussed forming a small committee comprised of a Selectmen, a Trustee and a member of the Facilities Committee to see the remediation through.

**Eversource Rate Hearing:** Jen said she was planning to testify on behalf of the Town in the Eversource Rate case in front of the Department of Public Utilities. This would require her to be away on August 2<sup>nd</sup>. Skipper said he would also be unable to attend the meeting on August 2<sup>nd</sup> so it has been cancelled unless there is an emergency.
