Garden Club Event Permit & Charity Wine: S. Manter motioned to allow the Garden Club event and grant a Charity Wine license for June 23, 2016 provided they had all appropriate signoffs. C. Mitchell seconded the motion. The vote on the motion was unanimous in favor.

Lambert's Cove Beach Federal Flood Protection: The Board spoke by phone with Elmer Knoderer, a consultant to the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Department about an inquiry they had received regarding the status of flood development protection at Lambert's Cove Beach. Skipper noted that the two lots in question on the provided map were not owned by the town. Mr. Knoderer asked for parcel data showing ownership and said that would likely resolve the question. Regarding the protection status of the town owned parcel, it was noted that while most development projects would not be eligible for federal funding, some that would enhance the goals of fish and wildlife would be eligible for funding even with the current enhanced protection designation. The Board seemed satisfied that the beach remains in the current higher level of protection, and Jen will send parcel data for the other two parcels to Mr. Knoderer.

Facilities Maintenance Consultant Request for Proposals (RFP): S. Manter motioned to approve the RFP as amended the week prior. C. Mitchell seconded the motion. The vote on the motion was unanimous in favor.

Land Bank Trail Signs on Stoney Hill and Checamo Path: Jen explained that the Land Bank wished to erect signs on the two paths, but needed permission from the Board per the management agreement.
