

**A brief update of West Tisbury orders
April 3,2020**

The Board of Selectmen and Board of Health have extended the Stay at Home Order until May 4th, in line with the Governor's order. The Construction Ban has been extended to April 21st. Right now there is a working group made up of Building Inspectors, Health Agents and people in the construction industry working to develop safe work site regulations to be put into place when the job sites reopen. These regulations are expected to be complete by April 10th. This will allow everyone time to put into place the things they need to do to be allowed to re-open.

It is our goal, first and foremost, to protect the health and safety of the citizens of Martha's Vineyard. We know these restrictions are difficult but best practices to slow the spread of this virus requires that we all stay at home, limit our interactions with others, practice social distancing when we must go out and finally – wash our hands!
