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Please explain the article in sufficient detail so that it will be easily understood by anyone attending town meeting.

The Finance Committee has, for the past several years stated that those departments that levy User fees should adjust those fees periodically to more closely match the expenses associated with them. The Board of Health did so in 2018 at the FinCom's request and has committed to doing so periodically. The Select Board is the governing body for setting Building Department fees. It has adjusted inspection fees to match the cost of paying inspectors but has not adjusted permit fees (historically approximately 50% - 60% of revenue) despite multiple requests. The building department's income shortfall – see chart below –was historically about 25% of its total budget. That is higher than we believe is appropriate, and it has grown dramatically in the past few years, projected to be over 36% for FY2023.
