## Dear Chair and Members:

The presence of unvaccinated staff at the Council on Aging constitutes a breach of trust, not only with Seniors, but with all the Town's citizens. Fortunately, the MGH-Brigham hospital group has set the example by requiring all of their employees to be vaccinated.
