

Marthas Vineyard Distilling Company Inc.

I have grown up and lived at 343 State road since 1988, with my family. We farm this property with Large flower fields and Vegetable gardens, Juniper trees and various animals. We are a member of the Massachusetts Farm Bureau, and have attended and been a member of the WT farmers market for almost 40 years. MVDC was started in 2014 and moved to 343 state road in 2018-2019. MVDC is a farm distillery licensed by the FDA, TTB, ABCC and Mass DOT. We carry all necessary insurances, bonding and have been issued all licensing needed to run our distillery. At this time I am not looking for approval to allow consumers permission to consume or purchase alcohol at 343 state road. We will produce, bottle and package spirits for sale to all licensed retail locations. In addition to the distillery licensing, I have Salesman and Transportation licenses for our products from the state of Massachusetts to make the deliveries and sales of our spirits. MVDC does not have employees and no additional traffic will be on 343 state road. The distillery is in the 30x30 steel building located in the back of the property at 343 state road. Along with spirits we will be producing Sanitizers to help with Covid and any virus in the future. I plan to continue towards making MVDC a zero waist company with and consuming only renewable energy. The hand sanitizer has also been approved through my distillery license through the ABCC, TTB, and Ma DOT. Hand sanitizer doesn't require much room inside the distillery and we do use all separate equipment for bottling the products. Our hand sanitizer is a alcohol base product so it isn't very different from what we already produce. Every item we offer is made separate and during separate visits to work since I do it all mainly myself. Our hours of operation varies but are 12-5pm Mon-Sat, and production from the distillery does not create any noise outside of the building, and no odors either.
