To the Members of the ZBA,

I have had to return to you because when I went to start building in January, I realized the plans I submitted to you showed the shed in the wrong location. This error occurred by accident. When I requested the site plan from Sourati Engineering last August, I gave them a drawing on an older copy of a partial site plan that did not show my complete property, and missed the location I wanted by one neighboring property line. There are six abutting properties on that side of my property. In October Sourati Engineering called to say they were coming to survey, and I told them they would see the site on the edge of a field, marked with neon tape on stakes. Unfortunately, the survey crew located the shed on the eventual submitted plan where I had indicated on my drawing, in the woods, one property away from where I intended it to be, and apparently ignored the neon taped stakes. I was not at home when the survey crew came. I did not notice the error when I first came to you, and discovered the error when I went to start construction in January.
