
Dear Giulia,

Unfortunately, the West Tisbury Zoning Bylaws currently define food trucks as a fast food restaurants and Section 3.2-3 of the West Tisbury Zoning Bylaws (WTZBL) indicates fast food restaurants are prohibited.

Feel free to contact me if you have any additional questions. If you feel aggrieved by this determination you may appeal the denial to the West Tisbury Zoning Board of Appeals within 30 days of this notice.

MV CLIMATE ACTION WEEK

The Community Event we're applying for permitting 1-2 food trucks is at the Grange May 14 10am-2pm. This is a one time event, lasting a total of 4 hrs. It is the culminating event to Climate Action Week; a community engagement project organized as a part of the MV Climate Action Plan being developed by the Martha's Vineyard Commission.

Climate Action Week, May 8-14th, was created to educate, inspire, and provide resources to Islanders so we can all participate in making our island resilient in the face of climate change. When it comes to climate action, it's all hands on deck.

The finale Community Event on Saturday, May 14 at the Grange features a range of climate action information booths (25+) from emergency preparedness, health & wellness, conservation groups, native plants, coastline history, aquaculture, Wampanoag representation, and more. There will be giveaways, art & children's activities, a film screening hosted by the MVFF, raw bar, an electric vehicle fleet, original music created just for the occasion by Molly Conole and Mark Lovewell, student speakers, and a presentation on the MV Climate Action Plan.

We feel that providing this service and education to the island is important on so many levels. To offer local sourced food during this event is not just about providing sustenance during lunch hours to islanders and families, but to uphold the messaging that local sourced food is climate friendly.

If we are not granted a permit, the extra planning and possible need to pay for catering tent and rentals creates an extra cost that we otherwise would not have incurred. People are donating their time in this Island Wide effort to support the resiliency of this island and community in the face of climate change. Being able to eat during the process is the necessary and humane thing to allow.

30+ Events during the week include aquaculture, Coast Guard and farm tours, films, exhibitions, conscious cooking, local food menus, home energy assessment workshops, carbon neutral building techniques, native plants and a climate action concert at the Ritz.

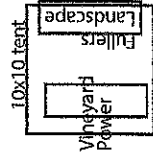

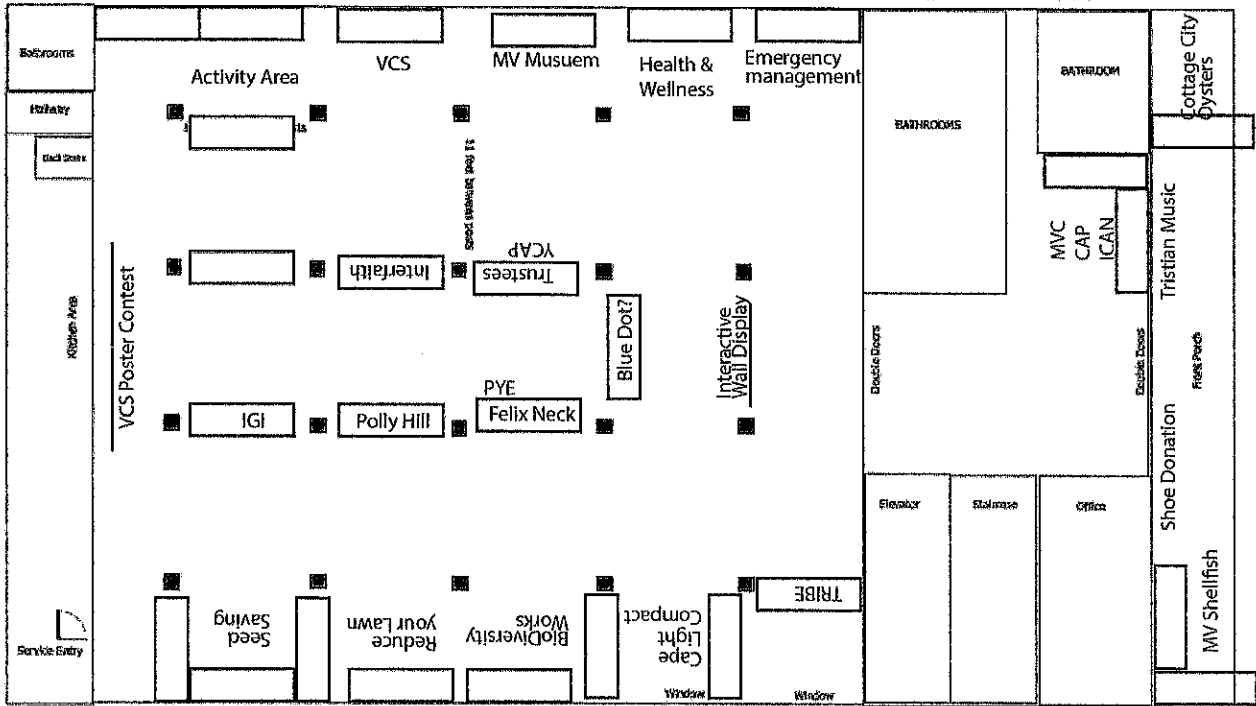
