Dear ZBA Members,

Here is a brief description of the proposed work.

Peter and Sara Bostock wish to install a Japanese soaking tub behind their house located on Edson Forest Rd off Littlefield Lane. They would like to ask for a 28' setback relief from the zoning requirement of 50'.

The overall size of the proposed deck is 11' x 11' and the over all size of the tub itself is 5'8" (length) x 35" (width) x 30" (height).

This is soaking tub which differs from a jacuzzi or standard hot tub in that there are no 'jets' pumping pressurized water or air into the tub. There is a pump which slowly circulates warm water from the electric heat pump to the tub and back to the heater. The pump will be enclosed in a sound deadening wooden box and the heater has a maximum decibel level of 50 which is similar to a quiet refrigerator.

The proposed location is desirable because it is on the back side of the house and will be hidden from one's arrival at the front door. It is located amongst trees which adds to the feeling of privacy and is well screened from the neighbors to minimize any sounds and visual impacts.

We hope these existing conditions will quell any concerns the planning board may have but we are also happy to incorporate any other suggestions.
