#### Proposed Project Narrative:

This Application is submitted in the alternative to the pending appeal of the ZBA's Decision dated September 23, 2022, and filed with the Dukes County Superior Court, Docket No. 2274 CV 00037. The Application, this narrative and all other materials submitted by the Vineyard Preservation Trust are intended to settle the pending litigation and therefore are submitted for settlement purposes.

The Vineyard Preservation Trust is eager to work with the Town of West Tisbury and its residents to reach an amicable solution that supports everyone's wants and desires for the use of the Grange Hall. While no specific impermissible or pre-existing use has been identified to the Trust, as a basis to start our discussion with the Town to address its concern that "the degree and intensity" of use at the Grange has impermissibly increased, attached to this Application is a substantial, but not necessarily exhaustive list of activities and uses that have occurred at the Grange in the past. Also attached are scaled site plans with available parking spaces and parking lots labeled Lot A through and including Lot E.

For the past 25 years, under the Vineyard Preservation Trust's ownership, the Grange has continued to serve as a gathering space for the Community and we hope that it shall continue to do so. Since our purchase of the dilapidated Hall from the Town of West Tisbury in 1997, the landmark hosts roughly 150 to 180 community events a year - 55% for nonprofits, 45% for art and community events, and 5% for for-profit events (weddings, etc). These nonprofit and for-profit organizations' art, theater, film showings, lectures, fairs, festivals, concerts, dinners, weddings, dinners, public gatherings, and expositions have been historically conducted on the premises since the late 1800's.

From year to year, the renters and types of events change little, with the notable exception in 2020 when the West Tisbury Farmers Market moved from the Grange to the Agricultural Hall. In response to the Community's call for the landmark to remain a vibrant part of the Community, the Trust rented the 2nd-floor theater to an arts organization. This move replaced the Farmers Market's 60 predominantly outdoor events a year with an average attendance of 1000+ people with 80 predominantly indoor events a year with an average attendance of 50 guests (the theater capacity is 70).

With the growth of the year-round population, the Grange is increasingly becoming an important space for the entire Community due to its central location, access to parking, and simple barn structure that meets most event needs. Vineyard Preservation Trust strives to be a good neighbor, self-imposing rules to limit impacts to neighbors and protect the rural character of the center of the Town of West Tisbury. We respect our neighbors and neighborhood by limiting hours of operation, staffing every event with a proctor, removing the trash on a timely basis, and not permitting outside amplified music, inside/outside deejays or extra tents that

increase the capacity of an event (small catering tents only). Lastly, we control the parking so as not to disturb our residential neighbors with car headlights or sound, while allowing the Community to use the field for overflow parking to keep cars off the village streets.

Today, the Grange requires significant investment due to modern code and safety requirements and ordinary "wear and tear," including a sprinkler system, HVAC, insulation, a new roof, window replacement, and foundation work. These projects are estimated to cost up to 2.5 million dollars. These projects are in addition to the annual maintenance obligations exceeding \$100,000 annually. The Vineyard Preservation Trust will work with the Town of West Tisbury, the Massachusetts Historical Commission, the West Tisbury Historical Committee, the West Tisbury Building Inspector, and all other necessary regulatory and permitting bodies required for these restoration projects. While none of these upgrades require a special permit under the West Tisbury Zoning Bylaws and are not part of this Application, we bring them to the Board's attention in the interest of transparency.
