I've always wanted to attend this one (see below) on Chapter 70 and school spending but could never justify taking a whole day and traveling off island to take it. Since this year it is being conducted remotely, it is a unique opportunity to take it as reduced cost and not missing a whole day in the office. Since the Town Accountant budget for this year completely eliminated travel and training, there is no money available in the budget to take this training session. The cost is \$250.

Chapter 70 and Net School Spending The FY21 final numbers are now final and are published om DESE's website. The FY22 preliminary Chapter 70 and Net School Spending numbers will be published on January 20, 2021, the third Wednesday in January.

That said, The FY22 Preliminary Chapter 70 and Net School Spending Workshop will be held remotely as follows (choose one):

This class will review Chapter 70 and net school spending based on the preliminary FY 2022 numbers including the status of the Student Opportunities Act. The Policy Maker class will focus more on Chapter 70 and Net School Spending concepts and less on the numbers, aimed at school administration and school committee members.

This class will explain terminology and how your district's local contribution, Chapter 70 distribution, required district contribution, and net school spending requirement are computed. This workshop will also review district profiles, foundation enrollment, how the foundation budget is computed, net school spending compliance, the compliance supplement, and municipal costs paid on behalf of the school district (indirect costs). This workshop also will cover net school spending for regions and how the municipal numbers fit into a region. This workshop is recommended for new school and town officials or individuals who would like a net school spending overview or refresher. Come to this session for a deeper dive into your numbers and to get your questions answered. You may have up to four people attending from your district or municipality.
