OLD/NEW BUSINESS: The Board agreed to hold the next Board meeting on Tues. 11/20/18 because of the Thanksgiving Holiday. Hans van Nes will let Health Agent Johnson know if he can attend. Board member Hans van Nes had no additional questions about his application for the 2018 West Tisbury Winters Farmers Market. Mr Van Nes had originally requested that he be allowed to cook sausage for sale at the market. Health agent Johnson reported that he followed up with Richard Andre in regards to the previously non-compliant shelter for turkeys at Whipporwill Farm. Health Agent Johnson reported that the shelter now meets State and town requirements. Health Agent Johnson reported that the pH at the Town library is low and that he touched base with the plumber from Haynes who shared that a repair required that the pH filter be bypassed. Health Agent Johnson will monitor the situation and push for the filter to be reconnected as soon as possible. The Board was reminded that there are Food Code Changes that go into effect Jan 1st, 2019. The official merging of the 2013 Food Code with the current code will take effect at this time, so all food establishments will be informed in time for food inspections in 2019. The Board was informed of an inquiry by the Council on Aging to provide Fire Extinguisher Training for Seniors. The Board did not disagree with the idea, but did not feel this was a project that they would allocate funds for.
