BOH Budget Review: The Board approved the budget. There were no changes from the previous year.

<u>Approve PFAS Support Letter:</u> Health Agent Omar Johnson is in the process of drafting a letter in support of opposing PFAS chemicals in any construction/building materials on Martha's Vineyard.

<u>Covid-19 Update:</u> Summarized the increase in the number of COVID-19 cases on the island. In the past three weeks, there have been 1055 new cases. The dramatic increase in cases is due to the recent mass wide island distribution of Covid-19 rapid test kits. The public was instructed to record their results on rapidtestmv.org if they tested positive. The town of West Tisbury is expected to get 1,350 rapid Covid test kits on January 18, 2022 and an additional 2,700 test kits on January 24, 2022 from Island Health Care. On January 9, 2022 the Martha's Vineyard Boards of Health held a vaccination clinic at the Martha's Vineyard Regional High School. About 550 children and adults received vaccines.
