Daniel Mayhew 11-85: Tentative approval was given. The Health Agent will sign off when new plans are received which include the statement "No wells found with 150 feet".



OLD/NEW BUSINESS: Updates by the Principals of both the West Tisbury School and the M.V Charter school were given. No major schedule changes at the West Tisbury school. Students (grades 3-8) are attending 5 days a week, K-2 day ends at 2:05. Staff Covid testing began last week and resulted in no positives. This week 40 staff and 40 students will be tested via the school take home kits. Students (K-6) are attending the Charter School 8:30 to 1. On the 21st they will be adding one day at the Ag Hall. On the 29th the students will be on campus. On February 1st the Charter school plans to expand the school hours from 8:30 to 2:30.

COVID-19 UPDATES:

The daily number of Covid-19 cases are shared with the Board members. The Health Agent reiterated that the numbers reflected post Holiday activity and appear to be leveling off, but surges can be expected as the cold weather force people into close quarters. Board members were informed that vaccinations for Covid-19 are well underway and that coordination of these vaccinations continue to take place between the Health Agents, the Hospital and Island Health Care. The Board members were reminded that we are still in Phase I of the 3 Phase plan. Hospital workers have been vaccinated and emergency responders are currently being vaccinated along with other health workers. The Health Agent reviewed what groups are in the last two Phases 2 & 3 and gave the time frames, February – April and April-June, respectively.
