Covid-19 Update: Summarized the decrease in the number of COVID-19 cases on the island. In the past two weeks, there have been 49 new cases.

Lifting mask requirements: The recent decrease in COVID-19 cases along with high vaccinations among the public has prompted the Martha's Vineyard Boards of Health to consider lifting the mask mandate. The West Tisbury Board of Health expressed support in keeping the mask mandate in place a few weeks after the Martha's Vineyard public schools spring break. Martha's Vineyard public schools will be returning to class on March 7, 2022. On March 2, 2022 a remote all-island ZOOM meeting with representatives from every island municipality will vote on lifting the mask mandate.

Agents of the Board of Health: Alexis Babaian and Patrick Roden-Reynolds were recently hired through the Inter-Island Public Health Excellence Collaborative. The West Tisbury Board of Health officially designated them as "Agents of the Board of Health" at the meeting.

Denitrification Regulations: Denitrification guidelines for the Town of West Tisbury were introduced to the Board. The Health Agent instructed the Board to review Tisbury's denitrification regulations on their town website because West Tisbury will adopt the same guidelines. A draft will be submitted to the Board on March 10, 2022.
