There was confusion with map and lot numbers in addition to missing measurements related to required separations that the Board requires. John Clark will be contacted in an effort to obtain

clarification and those corrections needed in order for the Board to conduct its' review. The Board was given a very brief update of the Municipal Vulnerability workshop that was attended by Health Agent Johnson on May 3rd and the 6th. The workshop conducted with the assistance of outside consultants (The Massachusetts Municipal Vulnerability Program or MVP) focused on strategic planning as related to climate change, sea level rise and natural disasters such as hurricanes. It was agreed during the two sessions that planning/improvements were needed in several key areas such as: The ferry, addressing tick related issues, communication issues, the electrical grid, potable water, road and bridge/culvert infrastructure, coastal erosion, food concerns and medical services. The consultants will compile the results and forward a report to EEA in order for West Tisbury and Chilmark to receive MVP designation.
