OLD/NEW BUSINESS:

Health Agent Johnson shared information from a discussion with Kent Healy in regards to ways to improve the water quality at Ice House pond. The Board was informed that Mr. Healy believes the use of dye to determine whether effluent from the septic systems is leaking into the pond is not a good idea because the dye doesn't always travel far enough to track a leak. It was agreed that the Landbank bears some responsibility for the abutter's concerns, and that efforts to address these concerns should be discussed and addressed in a coordinated manner. The Board concluded that general complaints were the responsibility of the Landbank and as well as being responsible for alerts.

The Board briefly reviewed the animal stabling regulations with amendments and additions from both Animal Control Officer Tony Cordray and Tara Whiting representing the interest of the Conservation Commission. The Board did not sign off on the amendments due to needing more information and time to fully understanding the proposed changes. Health Agent Johnson will provide the Board members with the current regulations so they can better understand the proposed changes. The Board is also asking if the Conservation representative (Tara Whiting) might be available to elaborate on the changes being proposed to increase their understanding.

Health Agent Johnson informed the Board that West Trisbury School curb construction project per Dan Doyle is no longer under consideration, therefore a discussion of the request was not necessary.

The Farmer's Market Compost Project was introduced to the Board and the Board's primary concern and request is that be emptied and cleaned after each session and monitored. This project will allow individuals

to drop off materials in a bin/container for composting near the rear of the Farmer's market location and to be educated on composting.
