BEACHES/EM/MDPH:

Health Agent Johnson shared with the Board information from MDPH (Bureau of Environmental Health's Food Protection Program) explaining the States position/interpretation on cannabidiol (CBD 's) and certain hemp derivatives as they relate to Massachusetts' wholesale and retail regulations. In summary the State has established that under current FDA guidance, CBD may not be added to manufactured food or to foods sold at retail, but can contain hemp seeds, hemp seed protein, and hemp seed oil.

Health Agent Johnson shared with the Board correspondence from MDPH from the office of Local and Regional Public Health. The correspondence was in regards to how this particular office assess the effectiveness and efficiency of municipal and regional public health systems. Provided with the

correspondence was a document summarizing the commissions findings which basically shed some light on some inadequacies in the system in terms of the ability of local boards of health being able to meet statutory requirements, keep up with duties, and provide important data to mention just a few of the concerns cited in the report. Health Agent Johnson felt it was important that the Board be aware of these concerns as they not only impact his ability to do perform his job as required by the State, but point out shortcomings within the entire State public health related system.

Shared with the Board the design recommendations for improving the safety around the perimeter of the dumpsters at the West Tisbury transfer station as provided by engineer company Wright-Pierce with additional input from Don Hatch. The Board has been informed that due in part to a recent accident that these steps are absolutely necessary. Health Agent will be proceeding with the steps necessary to improve the safety of the are working closely with the Town Administrator.
