## Minutes: Vote to approve -May 3, 2023

Cindy moved to approve the minutes of May  $3^{rd}$ , 2023. Jessica seconded. Roll call vote: All in favor.

### **New Business:**

### • Access to Counsel – Library Director:

This is retroactive for an incident that happened at the library. No discussion.

Cindy moved to allow the Library Director access to council. Jessica seconded. Roll call vote: All in favor.

### • Vote to Sign the Special Town Meeting Warrant:

Special Town Meeting will be June 13<sup>th</sup> at 7 pm. There are 3 articles. The board will come in to sign tomorrow. No further discussion.

Cindy moved to sign the Special Town Meeting warrant. Jessica seconded. Roll call vote: All in favor.

• Vote to Transfer Funds from Snow & Ice Budget to Highway Maintenance Budget: Richie has had some unforeseen expenses that need to be covered. Bruce explained that they can transfer between department budget lines and explained how it works.

*Jessica moved to allow the transfer of \$13,000 from one Highway department line to another. Cindy seconded. Roll call vote: All in favor.*  • Vote to sign the Intermunicipal Agreement for the Chilmark School HVAC repair: Skipper said it has been signed in the past but as it has been updated it needs to be resigned.

*Cindy moved to sign the updated Intermunicipal Agreement for the Chilmark School HVAC repair. Jessica seconded. Roll call vote: All in favor.* 

## • Discussion of Special Town Meeting Attendance:

Skipper is concerned about getting a quorum for the meeting. Janice has posted on the town website and on the Facebook page. Skipper suggested that the fire chief and the EMS chief make announcements with their departments. Cindy suggested reaching out to Donna, the WT school principal and also the MVRHS principal to activate the parent communities. Susan suggested posters in public places for those who do not rely on computers. Janice could design and print them. Kathy suggested getting the word to Hermine for the WT column. Cindy asked the press present at the meeting to help get the word out. They decided to discuss again at a later date. No action taken.

## • Cost Sharing Formula for Howes House

Jessica had done some more research and suggested 60 % for WT, 30 % for Chilmark and 10 % Aquinnah. Last week Skipper had suggested 50 % for WT, 30 % for Chilmark and 20 % for Aquinnah and Cindy's proposed 75 %, 20 %, and 5 %. After discussion it was decided to start the negotiations at 60, 30, 10.
