The focus of this meeting was to offer residences of Shybael Weeks Road and Red Coat Hill a time to voice their concerns about their roads, and deteriorating maintenance of the dirt road due to heavy truck traffic. There is added concern about pedestrian and general public safety.

At issue is a 200 year old road, now blocked by two gates forcing many residences to travel to Lambert's Cove Road to enter and exit. Effected are both Tisbury and West Tisbury.

This road is a recognized Special Way road/path.

Community members strongly felt that issues particularly of public safety, emergency vehicles access, pedestrian use were all threatened.

Harriet and Bill Veno then discussed Manter's Path and how the path travels through the Cole's property. Harriet and Bill met with the Coles and they seemed agreeable to having the path moved around their boundary line.

This information will be presented to West Tisbury Planning Board.
