

West Tisbury Complete Streets Meeting Minutes
Tisbury Town Hall, second floor meeting room,
April 11, 2019, 8:30 am

Present: Berta Geller, Rachael Baumrin, Tony Omer

Berta said that Oliver Osnoss is interested in joining the committee. She said she will contact him.

Tony gave a brief description of a meeting with engineers at the Lamberts Cove Beach parking lot and a representative from the WT parks and rec committee. He said that the group discussed reorganizing the arrangement of parking spaces and adding a second means of egress to increase the number of spaces and to simplify bus access with the goal of reducing on road parking.

There was a discussion of the desirability of conducting a formal survey of the parking lot to establish the boundaries and the possible cost. We discussed the money we have available for a survey of the LCB parking lot and whether the town would be able to put up the remaining \$500 to match Dan Doyle's \$500 and Parks and Rec's \$500 to cover the estimated cost of the survey, \$1500.

There was a discussion of the need to find out how to begin the work on the West Tisbury School crossing to improve accessibility and safety.

There was a discussion of plans to organize a public meeting at the WT Library on May 21 from 5 to 6 pm on the construction of a longer shared use path on Old County Road, including the need to create posters, a press release and a graphics. It was suggested that Jen Rand be asked to see if the Northeastern

students had any interest or time to work on renderings for the old county road work and asking the WT elementary students to draw their ideal bike path to school.

A discussion of the desirability of a permanent meeting time followed with no resolution.
