

COMPLETE STREETS COMMITTEE MINUTES May 26, 2022, 4:00 PM

DISCUSSION:

Site Visit to State Road RE: proposal to install a shared use path:

Rachel explained the details of the site visit to the stretch of State Road between the Tisbury town line and Old County Road. She said the committee felt the Stoney Hill side of State Road was best for a shared use path. Although it has telephone poles, the side of the road is clear and flat, the bounds are clearly visible and it appeared to be better surface for a path. The other side of the road has an existing trail but has several trees that would need to be removed and some of the terrain is rough with roots and uneven surface. Oliver, who had walked the road at an earlier date, said there would need to be a crosswalk at the intersection of State and Old County Road since the other side of State Road already has a warn path heading toward the Business District.

Old County Road Connector Paths:

Oliver said the committee needs to draw a map of where the proposed sup's will be located. He said we should consider sharrows or signage and Jane suggested the committee appear before the Select Board to ask for permission to install signs where needed. She suggested they be small in size and suggested an arrow with "Bikes" written on it. She said she would look up some signage on line.

Access to Dr. Fisher Road:

It was suggested Bill Venno and Dan Doyle be asked if we can send pedestrians to and through Dr. Fisher Road. Also, can signage be posted. Rachel asked if the road travels through the State Forest and Oliver said it goes to the high school.

Cross Walks:

Jane was assigned to gather a list of roads along Edgartown Road that need connector crosswalks to the State Forest.
