

COMPLETE STREETS COMMITTEE MINUTES June 22, 2017, 3:00 AM

MINUTES:

- The minutes of the May 11, 2017 meeting were approved as amended.

Kate moved and Steve seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous with one abstention from Katie Ruppel.

- The minutes of the May 30, 2017 meeting were approved as amended.

Kate moved and Berta seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous.

- The minutes of the June 8, 2017 meeting were approved as amended.

Kate moved and Steve seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous with one abstention from Katie Ruppel.

•MEETING WITH THE BOARD OF SELECTMEN:

Kate Warner reported that she had appeared before the Selectmen to present the letters to the Board of Selectmen and the Complete Streets Program. Kate said the Selectmen appreciated the advance copy of the letters. She said that Skipper liked the idea of roadside trimming of vegetation. The Selectman added a piece to the Complete Streets letter regarding distracted drivers, and the letter will be mailed out. Kate said we may or may not hear back. The Selectmen were not in favor of widening the bridge in North Tisbury and Kent Healy said he would like to see a bike/pedestrian bridge on one side only. Marc suggested that there be a discussion with the Selectmen regarding the Chief's proposed extension of the 30 mph zone in the MB District.

•CARS VS BIKES MOVIE NIGHT:

Jane reported to the committee that she had been given a quote of \$450 by the technician for the Preservation Trust to use the Grange Hall. She stated that the Planning Board felt the fee was too high and the Trust has not charged such fees in the recent past. The committee determined that a September 25th showing of the movie at the library would be best. Jane was asked to confirm that the library conference room was still available on that date.

•GENERAL CONVERSATION:

- It was reported that crosswalks are studied and engineered by the state so they can't just be randomly installed. Kate reported that Jen Rand is trying to get a response from MDOT about changing the speed limit and getting a flashing speed signs at the Charter School. Marc said he would like to see a fire lit under who ever will get the signs installed. He suggested contacting our representatives about this, and that the state would act if we stay on them.

- Berta reported that the paperwork from Howard Stein Hudson (Consulting Firm) has been submitted to the MDOT and we are still waiting to hear back. Berta reported that we can possibly be ready to submit the prioritization plan in September if we have a signed contract by July 12th. Berta said she will talk with Lou of HSH to discuss dates and confirm when he can come to the island.
