#### **Reserve Fund Transfer:**

Skipper has issues with this article which he has already told the school committee. He would like parameters set and doesn't like the idea of expanding the current footprint. Bruce mentioned that the Capital Improvements Committee gave this project a low priority and wanted more info. The board agreed they needed more info and asked Janice to have some come in to speak with them. No action taken.

#### • Article #23 – MVRHS Funding Formula agreement:

Skipper doesn't like this one either and has raised his concerns at school committee meetings. He does not object to Oak Bluffs receiving something for the services they provide to the high school, but it doesn't say anywhere how much. It's based on percentage and he believes it should be 'no more than or no less than' and based on a dollar amount. Also, the high school pays Oak Bluffs \$100,000 yearly for the services of a police officer; is that amount included or on top of what Oak Bluffs share will be?
