## Since the Cape Light Compact's Founding of CVEC in 2007:

# 6 CVEC PV (& Storage) Initiatives: ~ 64MW by end 2023

- Round 1 = 16MW mostly on landfills
- Round 2 = 12MW on roofs & municipal lands
- Round 3 = 1MW on 7 roofs (awaits Eversource)
- Round 4 = 12MW canopies, roofs, lands
- Round 5 = 14MW canopies, roofs, lands
- Round 6 = Now collecting projects & towns (for NMC savings on electric bills)

#### CVEC EV Cars & Stations Initiative:

- Electric Cars: grants applied for: 13 Delivered: 4
- Charging Stations: grants applied for: 24 Delivered: 2

- Legislative and Regulatory Representation:
  - Working with Senator Cyr for municipal relief from taxation of town's solar
  - Intervenor in case to halt Eversource devaluation of Net Metering Credits
