Old Business:

Investigating this will require additional funds and the job needs to go out for an emergency bid. Inwindow air conditioners are being utilized to keep the library cool and dry.

- A new refrigerator for the staff room will be delivered by Crane Appliance in the coming week.
- Feedback regarding the appointment system for the Children's Room has been favorable. Families are given the option of sharing the with another family.

New Business:

- The downstairs meeting rooms are now open by appointment.
- Fran will contact Dan Waters regarding a request for a Stan Murphy print which was offered by the Foundation as a fundraiser during construction of the new library.
- The new strategic plan will be due in April of 2022.
- The Farmer's Market has requested use of one of the library's wireless routers.
- Emily Fischer brought up the question: "How safe is the library network?"
- Library and civic building are asked to acknowledge the concept of the use Native Lands. This would not be a policy per se, but an acknowledgment of the forgotten history that all land originally belonged to indigenous people. Since the purpose is awareness and education, Rob suggested that it be included in an educational activity sponsored by the library.
