Director's Report:

- Library use and attendance at meetings, tech help and programs continues at near or above preCovid time.
- Wellness programs and book discussions are especially well attended.
- Children's craft bags are more popular than ever.
- Friends and Foundation appeal had highest response ever.
- 63.5% of libraries across the state have no public access, including WTFPL.
- Patron feedback is uniformly positive.

New Business:

- 2 levels of library access are available, remote and curbside, small group will be added in time. Some remote programs will continue to be remote.
- Alexandra would like to open the building once all staff is vaccinated.
- Alexandra's first year anniversary is coming up. Wendy will distribute the town employee evaluation form to the library staff and record and report their comments to the trustees.
- Flowers and dinners were sent to Linda Hearn, long-time library Friend and Foundation member and her daughter Laura, young adult librarian, following the death of their husband and father, Glenn Hearn.
- Discussion to continue the Landscape Committee in view of the fact that most of project is finished centered on the need to oversee the

upkeep, to create a garden in honor of past director, Beth, to erect signage remembering the Edey Foundation's generosity, and to expand the irrigation system. Suggested committee makeup included 2 Trustees and 2 volunteers, among others. Wayne, a member of the original committee, will contact Dan Waters for more direction, since the Foundation shoulders much of the landscape budget.

- Review of Policies and Procedures is beginning. Fran, Lynn and Wendy will work with Alexandra starting with the Art Policy and Exhibition Guidelines.
- The town Energy Committee decided against solar canopy over a portion of the parking lot. Trustees reiterated that the library needs a strong presence in any discussions of installations on library property.
- •Solar panels on the library roof with provide 50% of the building's need for electricity. Engineer's report has not been submitted.
