Minutes: Minutes for the September and October meetings were accepted.

Director's Report:

- Alexandra reported that in-person visits to the library were down,
 while the virtual programs continue to be well attended.
- 38 of the possible seats were filled for a music event; in the past that event would have drawn double that.
- The Friends and the WTL Foundation have sent out their annual appeal as one group.
- Dan Waters and Alexandra accepted a Community Endowment Grant for \$5,000. Alexandra was hoping to earmark the grant to buy and stock a community refrigerator with the intention of bringing sharing to the community. It would be located in the lobby and available to all.
- - The library functioned as an Emergency Shelter when the power in town was knock out by a powerful storm.
 - One septic pump in the basement was replaced and a second one failed almost immediately.
 - The power surges during a recent storm caused the Alarm system to malfunction and DSS replaced damaged parts.

New Business:

• the Library is looking for major projects to submit for consideration in

the town's Capital Improvement Plan. Curbings for the parking lot is one

suggestion.

· There are no evening hours at the library as yet. WTL is considering

the option given that several Island Libraries are now open at least one

evening a week.

· Oak Bluffs Library is experimenting with having one early morning

opening per week; it has proven to be a popular decision. Alexandra feels she

has the staff to offer the option at West Tisbury.

· From the Town Hall: No in-person meeting will be held through the

end of the year.

• In response to Rob's question, "What more should we be doing?" And

Wayne Smith's inquiry regarding landscaping and the irrigation system, the trustees began brainstorming ideas for volunteer opportunities such as a spring

or fall cleanup days to rebuild community and help the library keep neater

planting areas.

· Wendy asked if any considerations had been given to holiday

gatherings at the library. Alexandra has been speaking to her staff about this and is preparing holiday festivities for the 18th. Making it a daytime event

would make it possible for some of it to be outside on the porch. More at the

next meeting.
