- 1. Approved Meeting Minutes from July 18, 2022
 - a. Minutes were approved unanimously
- 2. Review Tree Surveying
 - a. About 20 trees have been surveyed at the rate of 7-10 trees per hour
 - b. It is not expected that this survey will be done by the end of the year
 - c. Observations on Process
 - i. Need reflective vests if near roadside Polly Hill has these and can make them available for pick-up email Emily or Tim
 - ii. Prioritization was important small volunteer saplings on side of road may not need to be surveyed
 - iii. Need to layer historic district map on top of Survey123 map
 - iv. Smaller group for surveying may help with consistent survey data
- 3. Funding Discussion
 - a. CPC Grant Application Eligibility applications are due September 22; Jevon will check if we need to do this
 - CPC Grant Applications are due October 20 with presentations likely in November; if funding is supported by CPC and approved at Town Meeting, funds will be received July 2023
 - c. CPC Grant will be sought in conjunction with but separate from funding through Tree Warden budget
 - d. Jevon has started the application and will work on it and send an email to inquire with everyone about the following
 - i. Choosing 6-10 high priority and high visibility sites for tree plantings or replacements

 - iii. Getting estimates of acquiring, planting, and watering/pruning trees for 1 year
